Subject: Possible Exposure to COVID-19

This letter is to advise you that an individual who was present at the First Service (9 a.m.) on Sunday, November 14, has tested positive for the novel coronavirus, COVID-19. You are receiving this notice because our records indicate that you were also present at the First Service on Sunday, November 14.

Even though we are not assessing this case as a close contact (meaning that the individual was not within 6 feet of another for more than 15 minutes), know that your health is our number one priority and that we are in full support of you, your family, and others taking appropriate precautions to mitigate illness. To this end, we strongly encourage the following steps to best insure your health and the health of others:

- We request that you self-monitor your health for 14 days and if symptoms develop, self-isolate and get tested. If you test positive for the novel coronavirus, COVID-19, please notify me. Also notify anyone you have come in contact about your condition and request that they self-isolate and self-monitor for symptoms and follow CDC guidance if symptoms develop.
- When you notify me, I will take the appropriate measures of notification while maintaining your confidentiality in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act and other applicable laws and regulations.
- We recommend you and any in your family who were present on Sunday morning, November 14, to get tested for COVID-19, and suggest being mindful of large gatherings and interactions with the elderly or anyone immunocompromised until you have received a negative test result.
